Boys 9-11 (Level 4 only), 9-10, 11-12, 13/14, 15/16, 17 and over.

ENTRY FEES

£4.00 per event for both the Level 2 and the Level 4 meet.

MARSHALLING

Swimmers must make themselves available for marshalling as soon as advised by the public address system.

OFFICIALS

Visiting clubs are requested to provide at least one qualified official per session, and their details (together with their qualification) should be forwarded with the entry information. Meals and refreshments will be provided.

MEDALS

Medals will be awarded for $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ places in all age group categories (including Open Events).

SPECTATORS

Admission Charges

* £6 per day or £10 for the weekend

Programmes will also be available to purchase.

CAR PARKING

There is FREE car parking for approx 250 plus there are several overflow car parks.

REFRESHMENTS

There is a coffee shop on site. There are also vending machines, and the local Cricket Club available for food and refreshments.

Promoters Conditions

- The meet will be swum under the following rules and conditions:
 FINA Technical Rules and Swim Wales Laws.
- 2. All entrants must be members of an Affiliated club, amateurs as defined by Swim Wales Laws and hold a valid Swim Wales/ASA membership number.
- 3. The promoters reserve the right to limit entry in the interests of safety and timely completion of the meet.
- 4. Over the top starts will, where necessary or appropriate, be used during this meet.
- 5. Entries should be submitted electronically using Hy-Tek Team Manager software. The events file for input into TM is available upon request from andrew.newportswim@orangehome.co.uk. In exceptional circumstances entries will be accepted using the standard form provided. No entries will be accepted without the correct full payment.
- 6. The entry fee is £4.00 per event, with a single cheque sent per club and made payable to "City of Newport Swimming Club". <u>All entries must also include a payment summary sheet, completed coach/chaperone accreditation forms where appropriate and a SAE of at least A5 for return of confirmed entries and the timetable.</u>
- 7. Age groups for boys: 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16 & 17/OV.

There are also events for boys aged 9/11 in the Level 4 Junior Development meet.

Events for boys aged 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16 & 17/OV are licensed at Level 2.

Heats for events involving boys aged 15/16 and 17 & over will be combined to reduce the number of empty lanes, but finals will be swum for each individual age group and medals awarded accordingly. Age groups for girls: 9/11, 12/13, 14/15, 16/OV.

There are also Events for girls aged 9/11 in the Level 4 Junior Development meet.

Events for girls aged 9/11, 12/13, 14/15 and 16/OV are licensed at Level 2.

Heats for events involving girls aged 14/15 and 16 & over will be combined to reduce the number of empty lanes, but finals will be swum for each individual age group and medals awarded accordingly.

For both girls and boys, 9-11 year olds who have not achieved the UPPER cut off time in <u>any</u> of their Level 4 events can swim in the Level 4 Junior Development meet. Swimmers who have exceeded the UPPER cut off time for the Level 4 meet in any event can only swim in the Level 2 meet - <u>swimmers can not swim in both the Level 4 and Level 2 meets</u>. 9-11 year olds can choose to swim in the Level 2 meet provided they have swum the consideration times, but entry is not guaranteed if the meet is oversubscribed, unless the qualifying time has been obtained (see paragraph 9).

8. Ages as at last day of the meet i.e. 5th May 2013.

9. Please note that each Level 2 event in this competition has a qualifying time and a consideration time. Entry times faster than or equal to the QT will be guaranteed an entry. Entry times falling between the QT and CT will be included provided the meet is not oversubscribed, with the faster times being given priority. Entries slower than the CT in the Level 2 meet will not be considered, and refunds will not be issued so please check your times carefully. All entry times must be converted to a short course pool.

Also, please note that each Junior Development Level 4 event has an UPPER cut off time. Submitted entry times for this section must be SLOWER than the upper cut off times. A swimmer who has already achieved a time FASTER than or EQUAL TO the cut off time for a particular event is not eligible to swim in that event. Nor can they swim in a mixture of Level 4 and Level 2 events.

- 10. No swimmer may enter events "Out of Age".
- 11. Closing date for entries is midnight on Thursday 28th March 2013. Entries received after this date cannot be guaranteed consideration. Please note that there will be no cards for this competition.
- 12. All withdrawals must be notified to the Meet Office no later than 5pm the day before the competition.
- 13. Competitors wishing to withdraw from a final must inform the Meet Office within 15 minutes of the lists being published or announced.
- 14. All weekend coach's/chaperone passes, to include a full set of results sheets and all programmes, are available at a cost of £15.00 per pass. All applications for this pass must include WASA/ASA number and CRB check details for verification and a passport sized photo. **Passes must be worn at all times when poolside or in the changing rooms.** The closing date for passes is the same as for entries, and passes will not be available on the day of the meet. Coaches/chaperone's without a valid pass will not be permitted poolside or allowed into the changing rooms.
- 15. Visiting clubs are requested to provide at least one qualified official per session, and their details (together with their qualification) should be forwarded with entry information. Meals and refreshments will be provided.
- 16. Marshalling will take place, and competitors must report promptly to this area. All finalists must report to marshalling at least 10 minutes before their event, failure to do so will exclude them from the final.
- 17. The safety rules of the pool must be adhered to at all times. Anyone not adhering to these rules (which will be read out at the start of each session) may be removed from the pool.
- 18. Individual teams/coaches will be responsible for their own swimmers in all areas outside the pool including the changing rooms. The first 4 rows of spectator seating should be used by swimmers and coaches only.
- 19. All valuables/clothing etc. left in the changing rooms will be entirely at the owner's risk.
- 20. Events will be swum in heats, slowest to fastest, with every heat (as well as finals) being spearheaded. The top 3 heats in each event with a final will also be cyclically seeded, but this will not apply to heat declared winner events.
- 21. The fastest three in each event will receive medals (in Open events this is by age group).
- 22. DATA PROTECTION ACT 1998 CITY OF NEWPORT SWIMMING CLUB uses a computer to record entries and results. By submitting entries and accepting entry to the meet, consent is thereby

given (as required under the Data Protection Act 1998) to the holding of personal information in a computer/s. Personal data recorded, such as name, club, date of birth and times may be made public during or after the meet.

- 24. The first session on day one will have a warm-up time of 7.30am and a start time of 8.30am. Warm up and start times for sessions 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 will be confirmed when all entries have been received and processed. Details will be returned with the confirmation of entries.
- 25. Acceptable Behaviour Behavior becomes "unacceptable" when it is considered "offensive" to others; this includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - Theft, willful damage to property and / or equipment, acts of vandalism, abuse of alcohol and / or drugs, bullying, offensive language, aggressive / violent acts, threatening behavior, all breaches of safety practices, failure to comply with instructions / directions, actions that bring the sport of swimming into disrepute.
- 26. Jewellery For safety and security reasons, the wearing of jewellery is not permitted while in the water during wa rm-ups / swim -downs and / or com petition. This include s watches, ne cklaces, chai ns, bangles, wrist bands, ear-rings (except studs), and rings (except wedding bands).
 Swim Wales will not be responsible for any jewellery brought to events and will not be liable if such jewellery is lost or damaged.
- 27. Competitive Start Award –

Swimmers must have attained the standard of the Competitive Start Award in order to start from the blocks; (this is the responsibility of the club coach).

Swimmers who have not attained the standard of the Competitive Start Award must lower themselves into over the side into the water, on the long whistle of the Referee before starting at an appropriate place.

28. When a competition involves children under the age of 18 years it is a mandatory meet license requirement that all persons (including competitors/officials/volunteers/spectators), wishing to engage in any kid of photographic activity including video, zoom, close range photography, irrespective of the nature of the device/equipment used for taking/recording such images must register their details with the event management in advance of taking any images. This includes, but is not limited to:

Cine cameras

Video cameras

Camera/video enabled mobile phones

Camera enabled PDA's.

- 29. The promoters reserve the right to remove anyone for misconduct.
- 30. The promoters reserve the right to remove or amend any of the above conditions as required.
