



### Swim Wales Legends Meet (Closed) (50m) 2015

This meet is aimed at Welsh registered development swimmers aged 9-15 years who:

1. Hold no long course time in an event
2. Hold a long course time that is older than 12 months on the first day of the meet
3. Hold a long course time that is slower than the published upper qualifying time for this meet

#### General Conditions

- (a) Swim Wales reserves full control over all Swim Wales National competition.
- (b) The 2015 meet shall be held on 18<sup>th</sup> (PM) – 20<sup>th</sup> Sept at Wales National Pool, Swansea, SA2 8 QG
- (c) The meet will be run under the Swim Wales general meet conditions, Technical Rules of FINA and any additional conditions published in the Meet Information.
- (d) The meet will be run under the Swim Wales general meet conditions, FINA Technical Rules of swimming and any additional conditions published in the Meet Information.
- (e) Ages as at the year of birth
- (f) Entries will close at **12 noon on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2015.**

#### The events

- (a) **Age Groups: Male & Female**  
9-11 years/ 12-13 years / 14 - 15 years
- (b) All events are closed to Welsh registered swimmers
- (c) All events will be Heat Declared Winner in each age group (i.e 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12 yrs, 13yrs, 14 yrs, and 15 yrs).
- (d) Heats will be seeded slow to fast

## **Entries**

- (a) Entries shall be received by the National Entries Administrator by the relevant closing date accompanied by the relevant entry fee. (Individual £5.00). Entry will be by means of an online system. Cheques/BACS payments will not be accepted for payment. Payment must be made for all entries at the time of entry via the online system.
- (b) Entry will be on a first come first serve basis with events being restricted to 2 heats per age (i.e. 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12 yrs, 13yrs, 14 yrs and 15 yrs). Entry for each event will close as soon as the allocated numbers of heats are full.
- (c) The National Entries Administrator may request validation of any stated entry time.

## **Administration**

- (a) Coaches will be required to obtain an accreditation pass in advance of the closing date for entries, unless they hold a Swim Wales Annual Coaches pass. Application forms for accreditation are available from the event webpage.
- (b) Coach's accreditation will be issued on arrival at the competition venue. Please bring photographic ID for collection purposes. No passes will be issued during the meet.
- (c) All competing clubs will have an information box located at the Information Desk in the front reception area. This will be used for communication purposes during the meet.

## **Withdrawal from events**

- (a) Swim Wales no longer require withdrawal notification from heats. Lanes will be swum empty where a competitor is not present.

## **Marshalling**

- (a) **Heats:** Swimmers must report to poolside marshalling located adjacent to the changing village entrance. Swimmers should follow the directions given by the Steward. It is the swimmers responsibility to report in good time.

## **Trophies & Medals**

- (a) Medals will be awarded to the swimmers placed first, second and third in each age. (i.e 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12 yrs, 13yrs, 14 yrs and 15 yrs).

### **Spectator Fees**

(a) Session, day and weekend tickets will be available for spectators. Tickets will be limited based on available seating areas.

Ticket prices: £2.00 per session

£4.50 Saturday Day Pass

£10.00 weekend pass (only sold on the first day of the meet)

(b) Concessionary rates are available for disability, students and senior citizens if supported with valid documentation.

### **Photography**

(a) During the competition professional photographers or the media appointed by Swim Wales maybe present. Any photographs taken maybe published.

(b) When the competition involves young persons under the age of 18 years all types of photographic/videoing equipment (including a mobile phone with image capturing facility) should be registered on arrival. Photographic bands should be visible when using any equipment.
