For 2016 the Swim Wales New Year meet will have a change of format to a Swimming Pentathlon event. The Swim Wales New Year Swimming Pentathlon Championships is a level 3 open long course (50m) meet aimed at development swimmers. The meet is designed to encourage development swimmers to compete in a variety of disciplines and avoid specialization early in their swimming career.

Entry Criteria

Entry will only be accepted from competitors who hold a valid membership of Swim Wales, ASA or SASA, or competitors from one of the countries affiliated to FINA.

Entry will be by means of an online system requiring instant payment via PayPal, debit/credit card. Overseas entry will be made via email using the 'overseas entry form' located at the event webpage.

Entry will open: 7am Monday 16thth November 2015.

Entry will close: Noon Wednesday 16th December 2015

Entry will only be open to swimmers who have not qualified to swim in the Swim Wales National Short Course Championships. Please note that if a swimmer is/was eligible to swim in ANY event in the Swim Wales National Short Course Championships 2015 then they are NOT eligible to swim in ANY event in the Swim Wales New Year Swimming Pentathlon Championships.

Medals and awards

Awards will be given to the swimmers ranked from 1st to 3rd on the ranking list produced for each age group for boys and girls when the cumulative times from all five events (pentathlon) have been collated. Awards will not be given for individual events within the pentathlon.

Entry Conditions

Meet Conditions

Entry will only be open to swimmers who have not qualified to swim in the Swim Wales National Short Course Championships. Please note that if a swimmer is/was eligible to swim in ANY event in the Swim Wales National Short Course Championships 2015 then they are NOT eligible to swim in ANY event in the Swim Wales New Year Swimming Pentathlon Championships.

Meet Administration

Coaches/ Chaperones/Team Manager Passes

Coaches/Chaperones/ Team Managers will not be allowed on poolside without a valid meet pass. All applicants must hold a current Swim Wales/ ASA/ SASA membership and CRB check. Annual Coaches Passes issued to Welsh Clubs can be used at this event.

Competition Pass costs:

One coaches pass - £10

One Head Coaches Pass & 1 Team Manager Pass - £20

Meet Withdraw Procedure

Swim Wales no longer require withdraw from heat events. Lanes will be swum empty where a competitor is not present

Refunds

Refunds for Entry Fees will only be made on receipt of a Valid Doctors Certificate.

Marshalling

Heats: Swimmers **must** report to poolside marshalling located adjacent to the changing village entrance. Swimmers should follow the directions given by the Steward. It is the swimmers responsibility to report in good time.

Photography

- (a) During the competition professional photography, video or the media appointed by Swim Wales maybe present. Any photographs taken maybe published.
- (b) When the competition involves young persons under the age of 18 years all types of photographic/videoing equipment (including a mobile phone with image capturing facility) should be registered on arrival. Photographic bands should be visible when using any equipment.
